

The International Baccalaureate (IB)

Brookes Moscow will adopt and develop the three programmes of the IB - The Primary Years Programme (PYP); the Middle Years Programme (MYP) and the Diploma Programme (DP).

Location, Site and Facilities

State of the art facilities, close to the Botanical Gardens, Moscow and a sustainable new campus with excellent communication links - school buses and close to a new metro station. The territory of the school campus is bordered by parkland and the Yauza River, which will be designed by a Japanese architectural Bureau. Within the landscape of the school will be walking trails, playgrounds and multipurpose sports grounds, and also gardens for outside learning.

Wrap Around Pastoral Care

Brookes Moscow will be committed to providing a service to parents outside of normal school working hours. In order to facilitate those parents who require an early morning drop off, the school will provide a before school care facility. After school homework supervision, activities, supper and late pickup will be offered, to facilitate working families.

Our pastoral care will ensure the overall health, safety and welfare of the children at all times. Suitable systems, supported by our counsellor and class form tutors will be in place, to guide children as they grow through the school.
